Booking an appointment

Please telephone the surgery on **01268552999** to arrange an appointment. Phone lines are open from 8am in the morning.

All calls will be triaged by a clinician who will call you back to discuss your condition and any treatment necessary. You may be asked to come into the practice for a face-to-face appointment.



Video/Phone call: Initially you will speak with one of our clinicians via phone or videolink. However, we will still ensure that your appointment meets all your needs.

Where photos are requested by the clinician, they will be confidential and saved in your relevant medical records.



Face-to-face: If you require a face-to-face appointment, a time will be arranged for you to come to the practice.

Trainee doctor

We have a trainee doctor available Thursday & Fridays, who can deal with many of the problems that a GP would normally see. The trainee doctor will also get guidance form the doctor on site.

Physician Associate

PA's see minor illness under the supervision of a GP, they can also assist GPs in requesting investigations such as blood test and imaging.

Practice Nurse

Vaccination, Immunization, Wound care, Diabetic Foot check, Annual Asthma and COPD check, Contraception, and other injections.

Healthcare Assistant

Health check, Blood test, ECG.

Clinical Pharmacist Medication review, Acute prescription.

Mental Health Practitioner

Stress, Anxiety, Trouble sleeping to name a few.

First Contact Physiotherapist

Musculoskeletal problems like joints and back pain.

Social Prescriber social issues and signposting.

Physician Associate Minor illness, Blood, and x-ray results.

Health & well Being coach

The health and well being couch will support your self-management especially for patients with long term conditions, e.g., COPD, Diabetes or prediabetes

Home visits
